Centar za očuvanje izvornih pasmina domaćih životinja u Buhovu (Rezervat), općina Široki Brijeg, utemeljen je 2006. godine.

U Rezervatu se može vidjeti nukleus stada ugroženih izvornih pasmina domaćih životinja. Cilj utemeljenja ovoga Rezervata je očuvanje i zaštita izvornih pasmina domaćih životinja, te time i očuvanje biološke raznolikosti područja Hercegovine.

U današnjoj, gotovo u svemu, standardiziranoj Europi, po tome i bezličnoj ponudi hrane, proizvodi od mesa i mlijeka ovih izvornih pasmina, osobito u budućnosti, predstavljat će prave gastronomske delicije. Osim toga, one su i dio našeg identiteta, te ih je osobito zbog toga potrebno očuvati i zaštititi.

Centre for preservation of indigenous breeds of domestic animals (Nature Reserve), municipality of Široki Brijeg, was founded in 2006.

You can see the nucleus of herds of endangered indigenous breeds of domestic animals in the Reserve.

The aim of foundation of this Reserve is preservation and protection of indigenous breeds of domestic animals, and by this preservation of biological diversity of the Herzegovinian region. Besides preservation and protection of indigenous breeds of domestic animals, the In present-day Europe, standardized in almost everything, and in this way with food offer without special features, meat and milk products of these indigenous breeds will present real gastronomic delicacies in the future. Besides that, they are a part of our identity, and especially for this reason there is a need for their preservation and protection.

Buša

Krava buša je izvorna pasmina na području Dinarida, a osobito za područje Dalmacije i Hercegovine. Za bušu se kaže i ilirsko govedo, jer su je uzgajali drevni Iliri. Buša pripada skupini kratkorožnih goveda, niskog rasta, čvrstih nogu i papaka, te je otporno i vrlo pokretljivo govedo. Buša je najčešće jednobojno govedo: s različitim varijacijama od gotovo bijele, različitih nijansi smeđe i crvene, do crnih; a mogu se vidjeti, makar vrlo rijetko, i prutaste buše.

Trenutno, Rezervat posjeduje 70 grla buše.



Buša cow

Buša cow is indigenous breed in the area of the Dinarides, and especially in the Dalmatia and Herzegovina parts. It is also said Illyrian cattle for Buša cow because it was bred by the ancient Illyrians. Buša cow belongs to the group of shorthorn cattle, with short growth, firm legs and hoofs, and is very hardy and mobile cattle. Buša cow is in most cases in one colour: with different variations from almost completely white, different shades of brown and red to black.

At the moment there are 70 heads of Buša cows in the Nature Reserve.

Herzegovinian donkey

It is relatively short, grows up to 110 cm, but it is characterized by strength, stamina and patience. It was mainly used as working animal, for carrying loads of

Hercegovački magarac

Rastom je relativno nizak, do 110 cm, no odlikuje ga snaga, izdržljivost i strpljivost.

Uglavnom se koristio kao radna životinja, za nošenje tereta poljoprivrednih proizvoda, odlazak u mlin, po vodu itd. Ima izražen lopatično-leđni križ koji je uvijek tamnije boje od ostatka dlake. Ima čvrste noge i mala, ali tvrda kopita.

Hercegovačka pramenka

Hercegovačka pramenka, ovca je relativno mala rastom, visine do 52 cm, dužine 55 cm, a tjelesna težina odrasle ovce kreće se između 25 i 32 kg. Po tim karakteristikama pripada najsit-



agricultural products, going to mills, for water, etc. Donkey has expressed shoulder-blade and back line, which is always darker in colour than the rest of the hair. It has firm legs and small, but firm hoofs.

Herzegovinian Pramenka sheep

Herzegovinian Pramenka sheep is a relatively small sheep with the height up to 52 cm, and length up to 55 cm. Weight of grown sheep is between 25 to 32 kg. According to these characteristics it belongs to the smallest breeds in the area of Dinarides. In scanty Herzegovinian conditions, where it was bred: rocky grounds with stingy vegetation, high tempera-

Hercegovačke šarene koze obično imaju dvorubne rogove, sabljastog oblika, no mogu se pronaći i neke koje su bezroge.

Herzegovinian multicoloured goat



Herzegovinian multicoloured goat has the body grown over with thick multicoloured, usually black and white, hair. Herzegovinian multicoloured goats usually have two-edge horns, sabre-shaped, but some specimens can be found without horns.

Domaća kokoš



Hercegovačka domaća kokoš, koju često nazivaju i pogrmuša, po svojim svojstvima, vrlo je slična divljoj kokoši. Vrlo je sitna i dobro leti. Mogu se pronaći svih vrsta boja i kombinacija, a nerijetko se mogu pronaći i potpuno bijele.

Prosječna težina im je do 2 kg, a kod pijetlova do 3 kg. Meso je vrlo ukusno.

Cilj je u Rezervatu zbrinuti i zaštititi i sve ostale ugrožene vrste domaćih životinja u Hercegovini.



Domestic hen

Herzegovinian domestic hen is very similar to wild hen by its characteristics. It is very small and flies well. They can be found in all kinds of colours and combinations, and often can be completely white.

Average weight is up to 2 kg and roosters weigh up to 3 kg. The meat is very delicious.

The goal of the Nature Reserve is to take care for and protect all other endangered species of domestic animals in Herzegovina.
